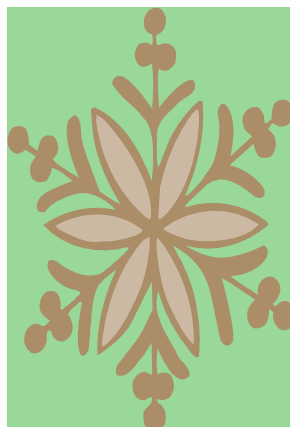


What a Tremendous Transformation!

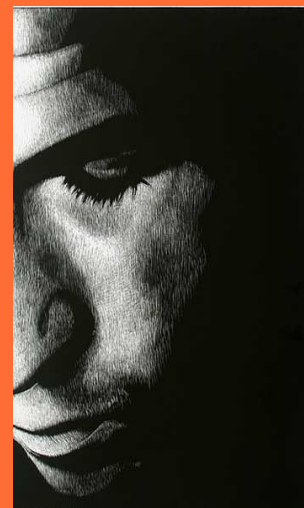


John's Corner

The gift of Marked Men For Christ ministry is to build stronger men for Jesus Christ. The primary focus is to help men become conscious of the areas of woundedness which have limited their growth in becoming the man Christ wants each of us to become. A great spiritual writer offered this nugget of wisdom, "When we become all that Christ desires us to be, then we will set the world ablaze." But until I continue to my work and pour out my darkness, pain and sin with the help of God's healing grace and the power of the

Holy Spirit, then I am destined to continue to transmit my pain onto those I love.

Here is a suggested exercise that might lead the men in our soul group to greater clarity, healing, and hope around the wounds each of us carries.



Read 1Peter 2:21-24.

1. Can you believe and accept Jesus' truth: "By His wounds we are healed."
2. Remember a time when you were wounded: physically, emotionally, socially, and/or spiritually. Do you have a physical scar? Where is it on your body?
3. Draw the scene on a sheet of paper. Who was there? How old were you? What message did you hear and take from it?
4. Are you willing to show the physical scar if appropriate?
5. How does that this scar and its message affect you today.....in behaviors, feelings, thinking.
6. Bring Christ into that situation where is He in the scene. When you gaze into His face, what message do you hear from Him? What part of this scar/wound strengthens you to embrace His healing...what do you need from my brothers to continue to heal?
